

LEGAL NOTICE

INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before May 31, 2019, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process, revised tariffs to offer additional LED lighting options to Indiana customers of I&M. Tariff E.C.L.S. (Energy Conservation Lighting Service) will add six (6) new LED lighting fixtures and open the availability of this tariff to subdivision lighting paid for by homeowner's associations. Tariff O.L. (Outdoor Lighting) will offer five (5) new LED fixtures including (2) Floodlights, (2) Post-top lights and a Dusk to Dawn option. Tariff S.L.C. (Streetlighting – Customer Owned) will make available rates for customers to install their own LED lights in spans from 1 watt to 250 watts. Indiana customers of I&M that currently take service under one of these tariffs or wish to in the future, will benefit from these new LED lighting offerings. A decision on the proposed revisions to Tariffs E.C.L.S., O.L. and S.L.C. is expected from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before July 10, 2019.
