

LEGAL NOTICE

INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before December 18, 2020, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process, a request to approve an updated Renewable Energy Credit (REC) pricing methodology for use in the IM Green Rider. I&M is proposing a new National Renewable Program option which will utilize lower cost Green-e National Standard REC's that can be sourced from a pool of many national renewable projects. The current Standard Program option will be renamed to the Local Renewable Program option and will utilize REC's sourced from I&M's solar, wind and hydro generation resources. The REC's under this program will continue to be priced based on the average prices over six-month period as published in S&P Global Renewable Energy Credit Index for the New Jersey Class I REC. The referenced filing will consist of the Company's IM Green Rider language changes to reflect the new National and Local Programs presenting a lower cost option for all customers. I&M customers potentially affected by this filing include those interested in voluntarily supporting the development of electricity generated by renewable energy resources by subscribing to purchase renewable energy credits under the IM Green Rider. A decision on the updated IM Green Rider pricing methodology should be received from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before January 27, 2021.
