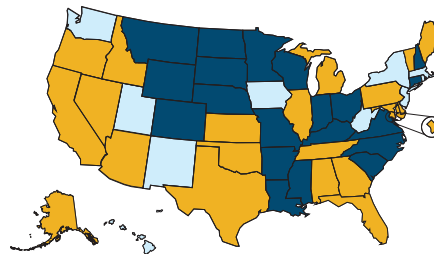
Smart meters use technology to give you more control over your energy use and help you save. More than 85 million U.S. homes have safe, secure and reliable smart meters.

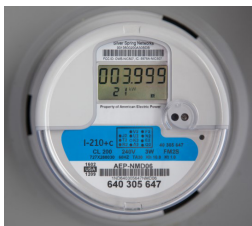
Percent of households
